FEBRUARY 2021

Entrants must confirm their participation by returning their completed and signed registration form to the BNP Paribas Fortis Art & History departmental e-mail address at artscollection@bnpparibasfortis.com between 1 and 15 February 2021, as evidenced by the date and time of the e-mail sent.

Only documents sent as **PDF files** will be accepted for participation in this artistic award.

Once the entrant's completed and signed registration form has been received, they will be sent an e-mail containing the Technical Documentation required to compile their folder of work.

MARCH/APRIL 2021

Entrants must send in their folder of work between 15 March and 1 April 2021 at the latest, ensuring it contains:

- 1. A portfolio of their artworks (as PDF files);
- 2. A statement of intent (maximum one page);
- 3. A sketch of their proposed project.

Please note:

Only documents sent as **PDF files** will be accepted for entry into the BNP Paribas Fortis Artistic Talent Award.

Your folder of work must be sent by e-mail to the BNP Paribas Fortis Art & History departmental e-mail address at artscollection@bnpparibasfortis.com in due time, as evidenced by the date and time of the e-mail. Work received outside the stated period will be excluded.

APRIL 2021

Four candidates will be shortlisted from all the entrants based on their folder of work. Those shortlisted will be notified by e-mail during April 2021.

A visit to the construction site of the new building will then be organised for the four shortlisted candidates, so that they can see for themselves the context in which the artwork will be shown.



JUNE/JULY 2021

The shortlisted candidates undertake to submit their model by **15 June 2021** at the latest and only after they have made an appointment to do so with the Art & History department of the Bank.

Shortlisted candidates and the winner of the award will be personally informed of the final result by e-mail during the first week of July 2021 at the latest.

An appointment will be made with the winner by 15 July 2021 in order to finalise commission of the work.

It is imperative that models belonging to the unsuccessful candidates are collected by 15 July 2021 by their owners, after they have made an appointment to do so with the Art & History department.

FIRST QUARTER OF 2022

Completion and installation of the successful work of art in the 'Cour Isabelle' and/or 'Cour Horta' patios will take place between January and the end of March 2022.

The award winner is invited to attend the inauguration of the work.
